

How To Perform A Basic Search

To search for incentive information, enter or select at least one of the criteria boxes and click the Search button.

1. Select **Type of Incentives**: (optional – default is tax incentive)
 - i. **Tax Incentives** - partial or total relief from income tax payment for a specific period.

There are 2 major tax incentives:

 - **Pioneer Status (PS)** - Income tax exemption of 70% - 100% of statutory income for 5 to 10 years. Unabsorbed capital allowances and accumulated losses incurred during the pioneer period can be carried forward and deducted from the post pioneer status of the company.
 - **Investment Tax Allowance (ITA)** - An allowance of 60% - 100% on qualifying capital expenditure (factory, plant, machinery or other equipment used for the approved project) incurred within 5 to 10 years from the date the first qualifying capital expenditure is incurred.
 - ii. **Non Tax Incentives** - such as grants, soft loans, or status to support business development or enhance competitiveness.
2. Select **Project Location**: (optional – default is All Locations)
3. Select **Ministry**: (optional)
4. Select **Agency**: (optional)

If you have selected the Ministry, only the agencies under the selected Ministry will be listed.
5. Select **Sector**: (optional)

User is able to do multiple selections.
6. Select **Sub-sector**: (optional)

List will be populated based on sector selected and user is able to do multiple selections.
7. Enter text into **Name of Incentive** field : (optional)
8. Click the **Search** button
9. Review the matching results
10. Sort the matching search results, i.e. type of incentives, by clicking the column header

The result will provide the list of incentives that would contain the searched word or criteria selected. Please click the incentive name in the search result to view the eligibility and criteria for consideration of the incentives.
